Welcome to netzspannung.org!

We look forward to receiving your contribution to “digital sparks” !

This is a brief explanation of the procedure and conditions for entry:

In order to participate, you need comments from your lecturer about the project you wish to enter, giving an assessment of the work and explaining how it fits into the teaching and research programme. Your entry will only be accepted as complete once your lecturer’s comments on your project have been received. Please speak to your lecturer before submitting your work. The closing date for you to send in your project and your teacher to make comments is 31 May 2003.

Projects that were already submitted in 2002 cannot be included for a second time.

Each student may submit one project, which must not be more than 2 years old.

You must not have completed your studies more than one year ago.

You can submit your project for the competition online at <http://netzspannung.org/digital-sparks/03/input/>. This URL requires a login name, which you will receive when you register on netzspannung.org.* Once you have logged in, you can register for the competition directly and submit your work. You will be asked to give the email address of your supervisor, who will then be asked to submit comments on your work.

Once all the data has been entered, your project will be provisionally accepted until we have received your lecturer’s comments. Your project will then be finally submitted to the competition.

You can make changes to your entry in your workspace up until the closing date (31 May 2003). After that date, you will not be able to edit your project any more. <http://netzspannung.org/digital-sparks/workspace/>

CHECKLIST: DOCUMENTS

The following information is required to submit your project to “digital sparks” online:

- » Personal information and details of your higher education establishment
- » Project title (max. 40 characters), sub-title (max 120 characters)
- » Author(s), collaborators
- » Brief introduction to the project (max 200 words)
- » Year and country of project creation
- » Key words / themes (pre-set list which can be added to)
- » Description of project content
- » Technical description of project
- » Specifications/system requirements for hardware and software

You can also provide the following information for your entry:

- » Project URL
- » Details of partners and sponsors
- » Project image in GIF, JPG or PNG format with caption
- » Articles or further description as PDF, DOC, RTF, TXT
- » Media files with captions (image, text, video, audio)
- » Additional media files to back up the technical description

NB: Please note that the preliminary panel of judges will assess your work online, so you should keep the volume of your data as small as possible and use standard file formats.
